SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 1st Quarter FY 2014


Contractor past performance reporting is a focus of the Office of Federal Procurement Policy (OFPP) and is of importance to the USD(AT&L). I am tasked with monitoring and communicating how the Department is performing on a quarterly basis.

The Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) compliance review for the first quarter found the Department is now at 81.51%, an improvement of 2.09% from the end of FY13. The Department's goal set by OFPP is 95% for Fiscal Year 2014.

The attached spreadsheet identifies the PPIRS compliance metrics as of January 3, 2014, and compares the fourth quarter FY13 data against the first quarter FY14 data. I commend those agencies that are making great efforts to improve their compliance.

The contract count includes contracts and delivery orders from the Federal Procurement Data System (FPDS) that meets the DoD threshold whether the action has been registered or not in the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System. The contract completed count reflects those actions that are complete and available in the PPIRS for source selection.
